The week beginning the 13th of November is National Anti-Bullying Week; we will be learning about bullying behaviours and how to address these behaviours in school and in life.

The children will learn what bullying behaviour is and what to do if they feel they are being bullied or if they think somebody else is. We will teach the children strategies to deal with bullying behaviours and they will learn that it will not be tolerated at Walter Infant School.
