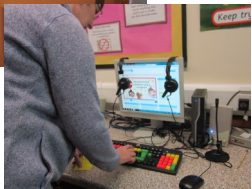
What helps you learn?

The igloo is also a quiet spot to calm down if something is making us feel unhappy or worried.

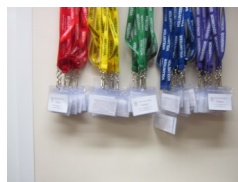


Visual timetables
