Summer Fair 2019

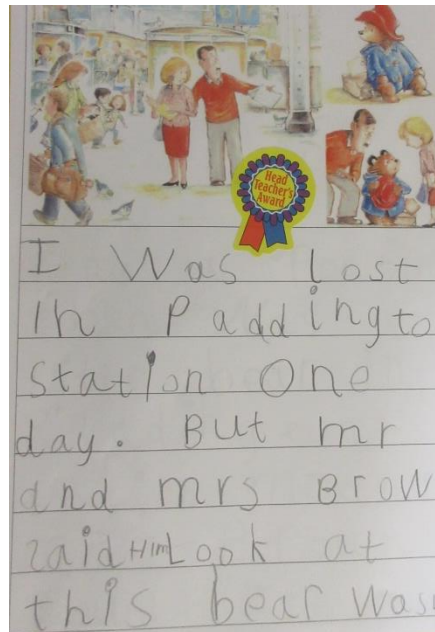
