If you are in receipt of – the Guarantee element of State Pension; or  
Income Support; or  
Income based Jobseekers Allowance; or  
Child Tax Credit (but not entitled to Working Tax Credit) and  
annual taxable income does not exceed £16,190; or  
income based employment and support allowance; or  
support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

you may qualify.
