






Dear Walter Families,

Legoland


Year 2 had the most AMAZING time at Legoland and so did all the adults! The day began with an exciting coach trip through the autumnal countryside where the children could see the changing colours on the trees and a variety of birds and animals including pheasants, kites and horses. As we saw the Welcome to Legoland signs there was rapturous applause and the children became even more excited! The sun was shining and we were all ready for FUN!

The session spent in the Education Station was really impressive; in Geography we are learning about the 5 oceans and 7 continents of the world. Our children demonstrated a really good understanding of this; especially Toby who explained that a continent was lots of countries joined together! We are also learning the difference between natural phenomena and manmade structures; the teacher showed us examples of each one from each continent. You will see below the models we built of the pyramids in Egypt, the Great Barrier Reef in Australia including sharks and blue starfish and an African Penguin. In Science we are learning about animals and there was a link in the session to that curricular target to. We all earned our popper badge!




The models were all spectacular and the session was so enjoyable.

Warmer Clothing in the Autumn and Winter Months



Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
