Head Lice

Some children have been arriving in school with head lice and/or nits; as you know head lice travel from head to head and they particularly enjoy freshly washed hair! Head lice is not a sign of poor hygiene or grooming, but it is a nuisance, spreads rapidly and can cause great discomfort for your children. Head Lice look like this:



Head lice are parasites and live on blood! They can live for 30 days and lay 6 eggs a day! They can make you very itchy and uncomfortable; the bites turn in to sores and can become infected. If everyone checks tonight we could be a nit and lice free school by Monday!
