

Here is a phonics mat and a list of common exception words to help you with your spelling. Try to use your phonics first; however, if it becomes too tricky then an adult at home or an older family member might be able to help you.

This week we are going to write "All About Me!"

You will need to think about yourself and how you look. Just like the two girls in the book...

Have a listen to Miss Rose reading the story.


If you have a version of the book at home you can follow along with us or even read it yourself.

Today you are going to use a mirror and write a description of yourself using adjectives.

Look in the mirror and look what you can see?

Look at your hair what colour is it?

What adjectives could you use to describe it?



Now look at your eyes, skin, cheeks, lips. What adjectives could you use to describe them?





You are going to write sentences using **adjectives** to describe yourself using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Here are examples of some sentences I made about myself.

I have long brown hair.

My eyes are blue and I have rosy cheeks.



Now its your turn! Remember before writing:


- Say your sentence Say it again Write it Check it
- Use Capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.








There is a word mat to help you on the next page.



Today you are going to be drawing a picture of yourself and labelling your body parts.


How many body parts can you name?

Can you point to them on your own body too?






First you need to draw a picture of yourself and your body. Remember to draw your neck, hands and feet.




Ask an adult to draw some label lines to the different body parts.



Now you need to name the body part using your phonics. Before we write a word we don't know how to spell you need to:


- Say the word
- Listen to the sounds you can hear
- Write the sounds using you phonics mat
- Then check it



Your child may spell it **nec** or **nek** that's okay as they are using their phonics.

Today you are going to be writing about your likes and dislikes using the conjunction 'and' and if you want a challenge 'because'. If you use the word because you can then tell me why you do or don't like something.

You need to think about what you like doing and what are your favourite things. Maybe even think about what you don't like.



Don't forget to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.







Here are some examples of sentences about me and my likes and dislikes.

My favourite animals are penguins and red pandas.

I like sweets because they taste yummy.


I love when it snows because I can have a snow fight.


Blue and pink are my favourite colours.


I don't like spiders because they have lots of legs.

Now its your turn! Remember before writing:




Today you are going to publish a piece of writing you wrote yesterday in your neatest handwriting.
