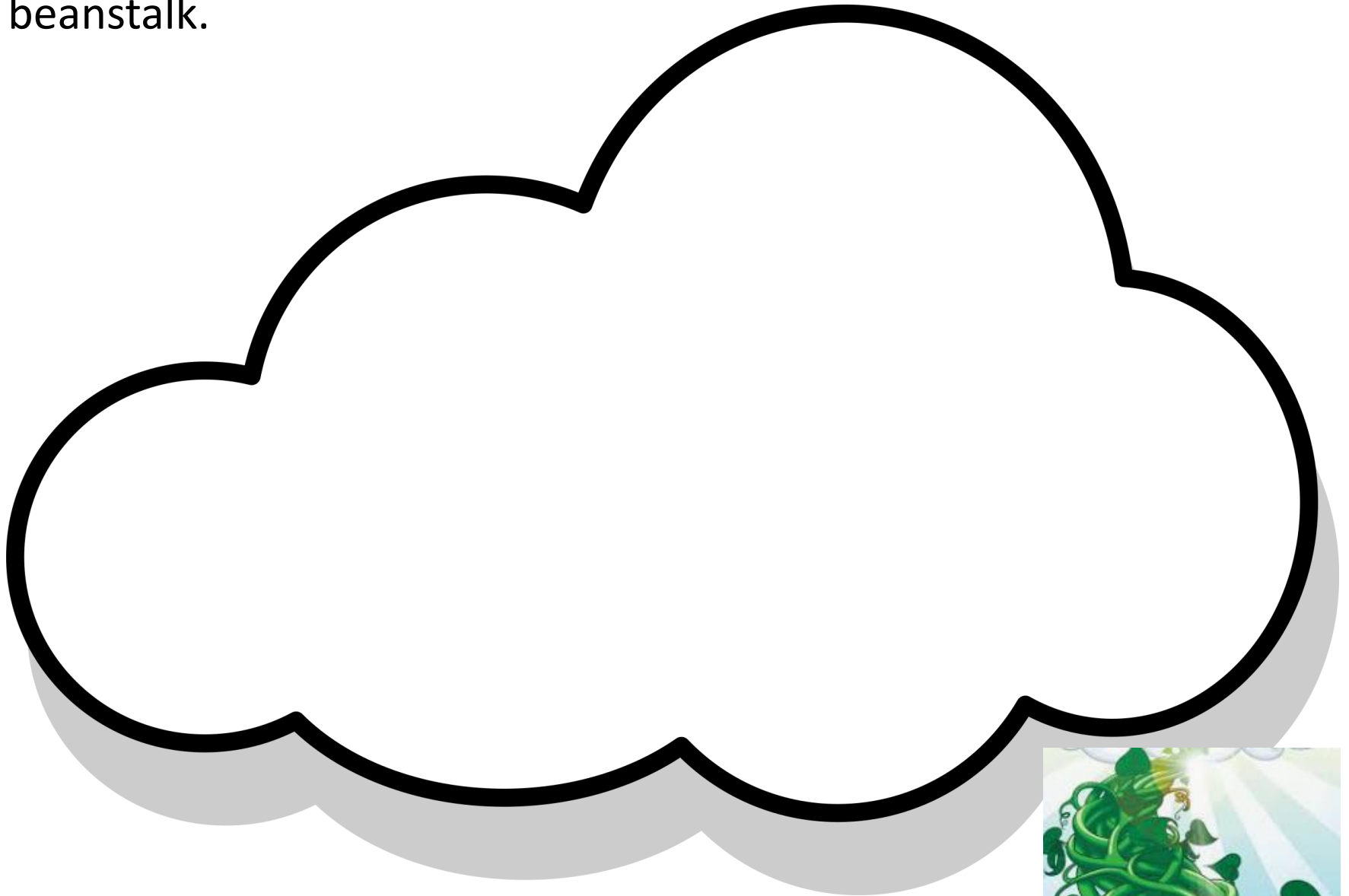
Activity 4
