# SCHOOL REPORTS AND CHANGE OVER DAY

Foundation Stage children will bring their school reports home on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July; if you would like an appointment to discuss the report with the class teacher Mrs Parfett (Magpie) will be available on the 18<sup>th</sup> July, Mrs Coyne on the 19<sup>th</sup> July and Mrs Lewis on the 20<sup>th</sup> July; you will be able to sign up for an appointment during the school day.

Key Stage One children will bring their reports home on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July; if you would like to meet with the class teacher, appointments can be made Monday 24<sup>th</sup> July by speaking directly to the class teacher. Hopefully the reports will have all the information you need.

The children will find out the name of their class teacher on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July and meet their teacher for a change over session on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July. We have considered the class groupings very carefully and taken many factors into consideration; including gender, term of birth, Special Educational Needs, ability groups and of course friendships.

We will not be holding the 'meet the teacher' sessions on the 14<sup>th</sup> July, instead we will be inviting parents to come in and meet the teachers in Year 1 and Year 2 on the first day back to school at 8:45 on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017, when you will be able to bring your child into school and come into the classrooms, if you have more than one child we will be able to make alternative arrangements.

# **DISABLED ACCESS TOILET**

As we will have a larger number of male staff in September, I would like to politely request that parents, carers and relatives cease from using the disabled access toilet (unless disabled access is required). We will now be reserving the toilet in reception for the use of our male members of staff and any visitors to school requiring disabled access toilets. Any children needing to use the toilet at the beginning or end of the school day (in an emergency) will be able to use the children's toilets in school. The adult toilets in school are for staff members and visitors to the school.

# SCHOOL CLUBS and SCHOOL UNIFORM

#### **Online Payments**

As you will know from our recent correspondence; we are changing our school uniform provider; after very careful consideration our uniform will now be provided by Gooddies; it will be available to purchase online to have a home delivery or to be delivered to the school for collection. #### **HEALTH MATTERS**

If your child receives a head injury or a bump to the head at home, please could you inform the school so that we can take care to monitor them in school throughout the day.



Please check the use by dates on any inhalers or auto-immune injectors that we have in school for your children and that you replace them if required.

We have seen some rays of sunshine just lately; please ensure that you take precautions to protect your children from the sun as the weather becomes warmer. We would advise that you apply sun cream on very hot says and send your child to school with a sun hat.

May I remind you that if you child has suffered from sickness or diarrhoea that they remain absent from school for 48 hours after their last episode of illness.



#### SCOOTERS AND BIKES IN SCHOOL

Thank you to all of you who have responded to my request to stop children from riding scooters and bikes in the playground; it is very much appreciated. We will have a scooter rack installed in the playground for September, where the children will be able to lock their scooters for the duration of the school day.
