The Start and End of the School Day

We have noticed that the start of the school day is very crowded in the Key Stage One playground; so, we are making some small organisational changes to ensure a smooth and safe **start to the school day**:

- We open the gates at 8:30 am school does not start until 8:40 am there is no need to arrive early
- At exactly 8:40 am the teachers will collect the line of children from the playground and take them straight inside.
- Any children arriving between 8:40 and 8:50 am can simply walk straight into school and to their classrooms.
- Any children arriving after 8:50 am will need to come through the front door and sign in.
- Please can parents leave as soon as their child has gone into school to avoid congestion
- No children can play on the climbing frame until after registration
 At the end of the school day
- We will be placing cones across the playground for parents and carers to stand behind.
- The children will be released from their teacher one by one once the teacher has seen the parent or carer
- Please do not feed your children in the playground; please wait until you have passed through the gates

Naming Uniform and Kits

Pupil Premium Funding

Some of our families are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding for their children; this is a wonderful addition to our school's budget and helps us to provided curriculum enrichment and support for our Pupil Premium children and all other children too!

Your child may be entitled to this funding which can be used to pay for clubs, uniform, additional support, one to one sessions, Canine Assisted learning etc.

If you are in receipt of one the following benefits you may be eligible for free school meals or the pupil premium:

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.
